### **Questions and Answers:**

**Questions and Answers No. 22 to 25 originate from the Bidders' Conference.**

**Q22.** \*This Question originates from the Bidders' Conference.\*

In Volume 1, Annex CC, Appendix 1, some TPS requirements include references to "section headers" in the TPS. We note that there is no section context in Volume 1, Annex CC, Appendix 1. We also note that Volume 2, Annex CB, Appendix 1 has paragraph numbers that provide section context. Can Canada indicate how bidders are to know where a section ends when referring to Volume 1, Annex CC, Appendix 1, and which requirements within the section will be evaluated at bid time?

**A22.** Volume 2, Annex CB, Appendix 1 needs to be consulted to determine the section structure using the "Para" column information. From the requirements within that section, only the requirements found in Volume 1, Annex CC, Appendix 1, will be evaluated at bid time.

**Q23.** \*This Question originates from the Bidders' Conference.\*

In the Financial Bid Preparation Sheet (FBPS) there is a formula to determine the required quantity of Battery Loading/Storage Devices (similar to a magazine for ammunition). If the proposed ISS-S uses such a device, how many Battery Loading/Storage Devices does Canada really require: One per Power Domain (i.e. one per 24 hour battlefield day) or one for each Power Domain Battery Pack required to operate for a 24 hour battlefield day?

**A23.** The Financial Bid Preparation Sheet (FBPS) forces the Bidder to include one Battery Loading/Storage Device for each Power Domain Battery Pack required to operate for a 24 hour battlefield day, if the proposed ISS-S requires such a device to operate. This is consistent with the list of deliverables and associated definitions in Volume 2, Annex CA - Acquisition SOW. The definitions of a Power Domain Non-Rechargeable Battery Pack and of a Power Domain Rechargeable Battery Pack include the following statement: "The Power Domain Battery Pack must also include any Battery Loading/Storage Devices required to meet the ISS requirements." As the requirement is to provide as many Power Domain Battery Packs as required to operate for a 24 hour battlefield day, it follows that as many Battery Loading/Storage Devices need to be provided.

**Q24.** \*This Question originates from the Bidders' Conference.\*

What is meant by Universal Canalphone vice Universal Canalphone Set?

**A24.** A Universal Canalphone is the disposable piece of an earphone affixed to the ISS-S Audio Display and inserted directly into the ear canal. A Universal Canalphone Set provide one or more stock sleeve size(s) to fit various ear canals, which are commonly made out of silicone rubber, elastomer, or foam, for noise isolation. The Universal Canalphone Set is a contract deliverable, and consists of a set of Universal Canalphones

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to be used with the ISS-S Audio Display. One set includes two Universal Canalphones, one for each ear. If more than one size of Universal Canalphones is provided, then a set includes a pair of Universal Canalphones for each available size. These terms are all defined in Volume 2, Annex CA - Acquisition SOW.

**Q25.** \*This Question originates from the Bidders' Conference.\*

Why were there only Small and Medium sizes requested for the MLCS?

**A25.** It has been determined that only two MLCS sizes were required. These two sizes were arbitrarily labelled Small and Medium and are expected to fit the vast majority of soldiers.
