Revision 005: This revision is raised to modify the Request For Standing Offer as follows:

1. Table of Content - Part 5 - Certification

Delete: 1. Code of Conduct Certifications - Consent to a Criminal Record Verification

Insert: 1. Code of Conduct Certifications - Certifications Required Precedent to Contract Award

2. Part 2 - Offeror instructions, Paragraph 1 - Standard Instructions, Clauses and Conditions

Subsection 01.4 of 2006, Standard Instructions - Request for Standing Offers - Goods or Services - Competitive Requirements, is amended as follows:

Delete: In its entirety

Insert: Offerors should provide, with their offer or promptly thereafter, a complete list of names of all individuals who are currently directors of the Offeror. If such a list has not been received by the time the evaluation of offers is completed, Canada will inform the Offeror of a time frame within which to provide the information. Failure to provide such a list within the required time frame will render the offer non-responsive. Offerors must always submit the list of directors before issuance of a standing offer.

Canada may, at any time, request that a Offeror provide properly completed and Signed Consent Forms (Consent to a Criminal Record Verification form - PWGSC-TPSGC 229) for any or all individuals named in the aforementioned list within a specified delay. Failure to provide such Consent Forms within the delay will result in the offer being declared non-responsive.

Subsection 01.5 of 2006, Standard Instructions - Request for Standing Offers - Goods or Services - Competitive Requirements, is amended as follows:

Delete: In its entirety

Insert: The Offeror must diligently maintain the list up-to-date by informing Canada in writing of any change occurring during the validity period of the offer, and must also provide Canada, when requested, with the corresponding Consent Forms. The Offeror will also be required to diligently maintain the list and when requested, provide Consent Forms during the period of any standing offer and any call-ups made against the Standing Offer

3. Part 5 - Certification

Delete: Paragraph 1 in its entirety

Insert:

1. Code of Conduct Certifications - Certifications Required Precedent to Contract Award

1.1 Offerors should provide, with their offer or promptly thereafter, a complete list of names of all individuals who are currently directors of the Offeror. If such a list has not been received by the time the evaluation of offers is completed, the Standing Offer Authority will inform the Offeror of a time frame within which to provide the information. Offerors must submit the list of directors before issuance of a standing offer, failure to provide such a list within the required time frame will render the offer non-responsive.

The Standing Offer Authority may, at any time, request that a Offeror provide properly completed and Signed Consent Forms (Consent to a Criminal Record Verification form - PWGSC-TPSGC 229) for any or all individuals named in the aforementioned list within a specified delay. Failure to provide such Consent Forms within the delay will result in the offer being declared non-responsive.

4. Part 7A - Standing Offer and Resulting Contract Clauses, Paragraph 2.1 - General Conditions

Subsection 11.4 of 2005, General Conditions - Standing Offers - Goods or Services, is amended as follows:

Delete: In its entirety

Insert: During the entire period of the Standing Offer, the Offeror must diligently update, by written notice to the Standing Offer Authority, the list of names of all individuals who are directors of the Offeror, whenever there is a change. As well, whenever requested by Canada, the Contractor must provide the corresponding Consent Forms.

Insert: During the entire period of the Contract, the Contractor must diligently update, by written notice to the Contracting Authority, the list of names of all individuals who are directors of the Contractor whenever there is a change. As well, whenever requested by Canada, the Contractor must provide the corresponding Consent Forms.
