#### **B. PART 2 - BIDDER INSTRUCTIONS; 1. Standard Instructions, Clauses and Conditions (Page 3 of 14)**

**DELETE:** in its entirety.

**REPLACE WITH: 1. Standard Instructions, Clauses and Conditions**

All instructions, clauses and conditions identified in the bid solicitation by number, date and title are set out in the Standard Acquisition Clauses and Conditions Manual

(<https://buyandsell.gc.ca/policy-and-guidelines/standard-acquisition-clauses-and-conditions-manual>) issued by Public Works and Government Services Canada.

Bidders who submit a bid agree to be bound by the instructions, clauses and conditions of the bid solicitation and accept the clauses and conditions of the resulting contract.

The 2003 (2012-11-19) Standard Instructions - Goods or Services - Competitive Requirements, are incorporated by reference into and form part of the bid solicitation.

Subsection 5.4 of 2003, Standard Instructions - Goods or Services - Competitive Requirements, is amended as follows:

Delete: sixty (60) days

Insert: one hundred and eighty (180) days

#### **C. PART 5 - CERTIFICATIONS (Page 6 of 14)**

**DELETE:** in its entirety.

**REPLACE WITH: PART 5 - CERTIFICATIONS**

Bidders must provide the required certifications and related documentation to be awarded a contract. Canada will declare a bid non-responsive if the required

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certifications and related documentation are not completed and submitted as requested.

Compliance with the certifications bidders provide to Canada is subject to verification by Canada during the bid evaluation period (before award of a contract) and after award of a contract. The Contracting Authority will have the right to ask for additional information to verify bidders' compliance with the certifications before award of a contract. The bid will be declared non-responsive if any certification made by the Bidder is untrue, whether made knowingly or unknowingly. Failure to comply with the certifications, to provide the related documentation or to comply with the request of the Contracting Authority for additional information will also render the bid non-responsive.

## **1. Mandatory Certifications Required Precedent to Contract Award**

### **1.1 Code of Conduct and Certifications - Related documentation**

By submitting a bid, the Bidder certifies, for himself and his affiliates, to be in compliance with the Code of Conduct and Certifications clause of the Standard instructions. The related documentation hereinafter mentioned will help Canada in confirming that the certifications are true. By submitting a bid, the Bidder certifies that it is aware, and that its affiliates are aware, that Canada may request additional information, certifications, consent forms and other evidentiary elements proving identity or eligibility. Canada may also verify the information provided by the Bidder, including the information relating to the acts or convictions specified herein, through independent research, use of any government resources or by contacting third parties. Canada will declare non-responsive any bid in respect of which the information requested is missing or inaccurate, or in respect of which the information contained in the certifications is found to be untrue, in any respect, by Canada. The Bidder and any of the Bidder's affiliates, will also be required to remain free and clear of any acts or convictions specified herein during the period of any contract arising from this bid solicitation.

Bidders who are incorporated, including those bidding as a joint venture, must provide with their bid or promptly thereafter a complete list of names of all individuals who are currently directors of the Bidder. Bidders bidding as sole proprietorship, including those bidding as a joint venture, must provide the name of the owner with their bid or promptly thereafter. Bidders bidding as societies, firms, partnerships or associations of persons do not need to provide lists of names. If the required names have not been received by the time the evaluation of bids is completed, Canada will inform the Bidder of a time frame within which to provide the information. Failure to comply will render the bid non-responsive. Providing the required names is a mandatory requirement for contract award.

Canada may, at any time, request that a Bidder provide properly completed and Signed Consent Forms ([Consent to a Criminal Record Verification form-PWGSC-TPSGC 229](http://www.tpsgc-pwgsc.gc.ca/app-acq/forms/formulaires-forms-eng.html))

(<http://www.tpsgc-pwgsc.gc.ca/app-acq/forms/formulaires-forms-eng.html>) for any or all individuals aforementioned within the time specified. Failure to

provide such Consent Forms within the time period provided will result in the bid being declared non-responsive.

## 2. Additional Certifications Precedent to Contract Award

The certifications listed below should be completed and submitted with the bid, but may be submitted afterwards. If any of these required certifications is not completed and submitted as requested, the Contracting Authority will so inform the Bidder and provide the Bidder with a time frame within which to meet the requirement. Failure to comply with the request of the Contracting Authority and meet the requirement within that time period will render the bid non-responsive.

### 2.1 Federal Contractors Program - Certification

Suppliers who are subject to the Federal Contractors Program (FCP) and have been declared ineligible contractors by Human Resources and Skills Development Canada (HRSDC) are no longer eligible to receive federal government contracts over the threshold for solicitation of bids as set out in the Government Contracts Regulations. Suppliers may be declared ineligible contractors either as a result of a finding of non-compliance by HRSDC, or following their voluntary withdrawal from the FCP for a reason other than the reduction of their workforce to less than 100 employees. Any bids from ineligible contractors, including a bid from a joint venture that has a member who is an ineligible contractor, will be declared non-responsive.

The Bidder, or, if the Bidder is a joint venture the member of the joint venture, certifies its status with the FCP, as follows:

The Bidder or the member of the joint venture

- ( ) is not subject to the FCP, having a workforce of less than 100 full-time or part-time permanent employees, and/or temporary employees having worked 12 weeks or more in Canada;
- ( ) is not subject to the FCP, being a regulated employer under the Employment Equity Act, S.C. 1995, c. 44;
- ( ) is subject to the requirements of the FCP, having a workforce of 100 or more full-time or part-time permanent employees, and/or temporary employees having worked 12 weeks or more in Canada, but has not previously obtained a certificate number from HRSDC, having not bid on requirements of \$200,000 or more;
- ( ) has not been declared an ineligible contractor by HRSDC, and has a valid certificate number as follows: \_\_\_\_\_ .

**DELETE:** in its entirety.

**REPLACE WITH:** 2010A (2012-11-19), General Conditions - Goods (Medium Complexity), apply to and form part of the Contract.

#### **E. PART 6 - RESULTING CONTRACT CLAUSES; 10. Priority of Documents (Page 10 of 14)**

**DELETE:** “(e) the general condition 2010A (2012-07-16), General Conditions - Goods (Medium Complexity);”

**REPLACE WITH:** “(e) the general condition 2010A (2012-11-19), General Conditions - Goods (Medium Complexity);”

#### **F. ANNEX “A” - REQUIREMENT (Page 12 of 14)**

**DELETE:** “The Department of National Defence (DND) has a requirement for the supply and delivery of twenty (20) bar code label printers - direct thermal / thermal transfer, including USB cable accessories, to Montreal, Quebec. These units will be used in both indoor and outdoor environments in support of inventory tracking of equipment and material assets.”

**REPLACE WITH:** “The Department of National Defence (DND) has a requirement for the supply and delivery of twenty (20) bar code label printers - direct thermal / thermal transfer, including USB cable accessories, to Montreal, Quebec. These units will be used indoors to support inventory tracking of equipment and material assets.”

#### **G. QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS**

Q1. There is mention of outdoor usage, but there is no IP rating specified. If used outside, what level of environment does the machine need to be protected against ? (what IP rating)

A1. These devices will only be used in indoor environments -- see amendment to Annex A.

Q2. Under Mandatory Technical Specifications, 1. Printing Method, Must have Thermal Transfer. Will DND accept direct thermal technology only for this requirement?

A2. No, we will not accept direct thermal.
