Shelters are not equipped to accept ISO twist locks therefore a blocking system will have to be provided to restrain the shelters from moving forward, rearward and sideways throughout the Vehicle mobility range and mission profile. The S280 and General Purpose Shelter installation includes a requirement for a fuel source from the vehicle fuel tank fitted with a quick disconnect and an electrical connector. The tiedown points shall provide the same functionality as the current plate and eyebolt assembly as indicated on DND Dwg 8280008 and shall interface with the cable/turnbuckle system currently used on the shelters. 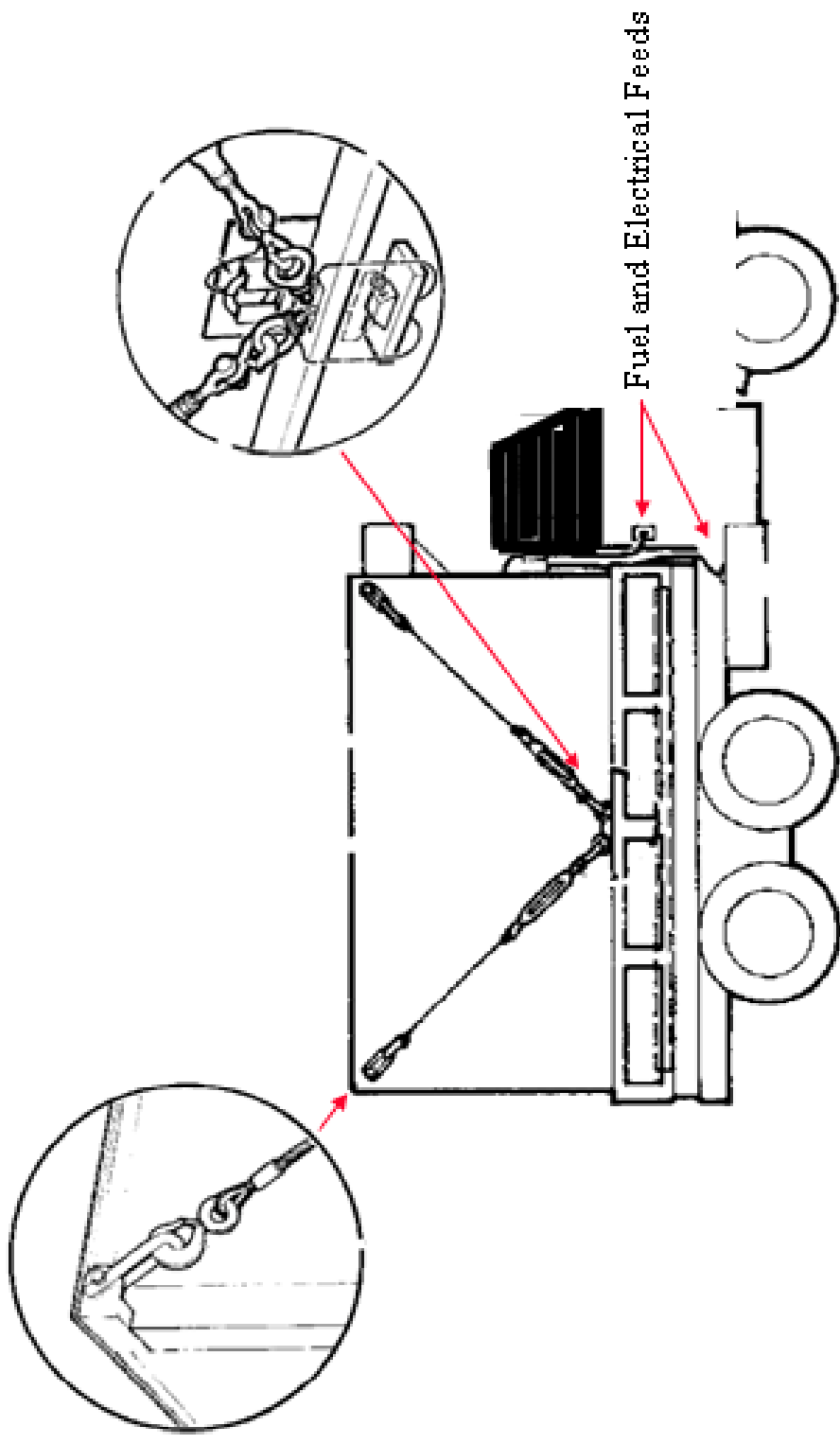


Figure 1 SHELTER TIEDOWN INTERFACE REQUIREMENTS
