#### Question 10

Section 3.4 Task #1 Activities, bullet #16: Prototyping of analysis and reporting modules so that Phase 1 functionality can be demonstrated to users, stakeholders and management.

Please confirm what the prototype is to include?

Reply:

The prototype is expected to provide a working model of the system including the Common Operating Picture, Decision Support tools and means to port external data into the systems. This should include the SAR support data such as recreational, transportation and industrial activities that are available through easily accessible public world data sources.

New Question:

Can the government please provide a definition of the Common Operating Picture referred to in your response to question 10?

Reply:

**The Common Operating Picture (COP) may be defined as a single identical geographic display of relevant information shared by more than one system user. A common operational picture facilitates collaborative planning and assists all users to achieve comprehensive situational awareness.**

Can the government please provide definitions or pointers to the “easily accessible public world data sources” referred to in your response to question 10?

Reply:

**The description of world data sources may included, but is not limited to sources of information commonly available through internet sources. This may include sources of recreational activities, industrial activity and transportation activity available through**

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**Stats Canada or company information websites. Other sources may include accident or incident analysis from international sources, prevention initiatives, international treaty information sources.**

Can the crown describe the expected interaction between the MASAS and the SAR KMS?

**Reply:**

**MASAS is a common tool for exchanging information among emergency management responders. The ability to provide an up today alerting view can provide system users with an up-to-date view of current events in near real time. The intent of MASAS is not to facilitate operational response, but rather allow users to have an rapid and comprehensive situational awareness.**
