Questions and Answers Set No. 2

Question No. 1: 1) On page 61 of the RFP document, rated criteria R1 for the IM Architect asks for "Demonstrated experience with enterprise content management, information architecture, business intelligence, information management, and data management with a focus on analysing, planning and deploying enterprise solutions". To score points in this rated criteria, could you please clarify whether each of the candidate's projects must include all elements (i.e., have enterprise content management, information architecture, business intelligence, information management, and data management), or whether each project must include one or more of these elements.

Response No. 1: Each project must include a minimum of one element.

Question No. 2: Regarding rated criteria stating: "Projects must have been within the last 5 years, and the proposed resource must have worked on the project for at least 6 months." Most projects within the scope of this RFP are for periods longer than 6 months. Based on the complexity and life cycle of this type of project would the Crown consider amending this requirement as demonstrated below to award points for the length of the project?

- 6 Months or 1 Project = X Points
- 12 Months or 2 Projects = X Points
- 18 Months or 3 Projects = X Points
- >18 Months = X Points

Response No. 2: No. Multiple contracts over 6 months duration on a single project can be counted as a separate project if presented as distinct work packages or sub-projects tied to specific deliverables.

Question No. 3: Given that the nature of the geomatics work is specific to Government of Canada; would the Crown consider adding a mandatory requirement for the resources to have experience developing and working with tools specific to GC standards, policies and procedures.

Response No. 3: No.

Question No. 4: Please confirm that rates submitted as part of this proposal cannot be lowered in Option Period – Year 3, Option Period – Year 4, and Option Period – Year 5.

Response No. 4: Confirmed. Submitted Option Period rates cannot be lower than the Contract Period rates.

Question No. 5: Rated criteria R3, R6 and R7 for resource category G.1 Geomatics Analyst, Level 2 and rated criteria R2, R3 and R4 for resource category G.2 Geomatics Specialist, Level 3 require the ability to perform code changes and develop applications. These requirements are typically not found with an Analyst/Specialist role but rather a Programmer/Analyst role. Would the Crown consider removing the programming language from these requirements?

Response No. 5: For the G.1 Geomatics Analyst: R3 has been deleted; R6 has been reworded to change wording from “developing GIS/Geomatics application” to read “developing vision and design of GIS/Geomatics application”; and R7 has been reworded to change wording from “developing web Geomatics business applications” to read “developing vision and design of web Geomatics business applications”

G2 Geomatics Specialist remains as is as this is a senior position that oversees coding.

The G.1 Geomatics Analyst rated evaluation criteria now reads as follows:

We find that there are several possible interpretations of this requirement and request clarification. Would Canada agree to changing the wording to:

“Demonstrated experience using techniques to identify business requirements in the course of facilitating Joint Application Design (JAD) sessions or workshops.”

Response No. 6: Agreed. The wording on R4 of Business Analyst, Level 3 changes to “Demonstrated experience using techniques to identify business requirements in the course of facilitating Joint Application Design (JAD) sessions or workshops.”
