Question 001:

Please clarify the increment requirement in 1.2.3 of Annex A (Requirement):

"1.2.3 The force applied by the hydraulic ram must be selectable from 20 percent application to 100 percent application of total force in maximum increments of 1 percent."

Answer to Question 001:

Maximum increments of 1 percent are required from 20 percent application up to 100 percent application of total force.

Question 002:

5.1 of Annex A (Requirement) states:

"The Contractor must provide a minimum of 8 hours of operator training and orientation on the supplied hydraulic press. The training must cover safe operating practices for the specific supplied equipment.

The Contractor must provide a minimum of 8 hours of on-site training on the orientation, operation, and safe operating practices of the specific supplied equipment at the installation site at CFB Esquimalt, British Columbia. Training will occur after delivery and installation. The training will be scheduled in coordination and agreement with the Technical Authority after contract award."

Does 5.1 of Annex A (Requirement) require two days of training?

Answer to Question 002:

A full day of work at the Department of National Defence is 8 hours.

The Contractor must provide a minimum of 8 hours of operator training and orientation on the supplied hydraulic press. The training must cover safe operating practices for the specific supplied equipment.

The Contractor must provide a minimum of 8 hours of on-site training on the orientation, operation, and safe operating practices of the specific supplied equipment at the installation site at CFB Esquimalt, British Columbia.

ALL OTHER TERMS AND CONDITIONS REMAIN UNCHANGED.
