This amendment is to respond to question.

Q21. Based on the response provided in the last set of Q and A's, and in an effort to provide a compliant proposal in response to this RFP to the Crown, bidders are dependent upon a number of outside organizations to provide the necessary documentation in order to obtain the University degree equivalency assessment. For example, the University of Toronto requires original transcripts and copies of the university degree to complete its assessment which takes a minimum of five (5) working days to complete. In order to provide the University of Toronto with this information, bidders are dependent upon educational organizations, many of which are overseas (increased time to receive the documentation) and many do not retain copies of original transcripts, nor provide these to the university graduates, ever. As we are sure the Crown can appreciate, the timeframes within which bidders are required to provide this documentation are in fact impossible to adhere to. As a result, our concern is that the Crown will find itself, once again, in a position whereby a contract cannot be awarded as a result of this solicitation process, despite having received bids demonstrating the market's ability to fulfill this requirement.

Given this is an administrative detail that the bidders nor the Crown can control, especially within the given timeframes, would the Crown consider allowing bidders the time required to complete this assessment process in the correct manner? We would, of course, be able to provide the Crown with evidence, on an ongoing basis, that the required processes of validation are underway and that we are working diligently and with best endeavours to provide the required documentation. Our contact to date with the University of Toronto and respective non-Canadian academic institutions does not lead us to believe that there will be an issue with providing the required certification, on or around the time of awarding the contract.

A21. Bidders must provide a CV of each proposed resource at bid closing that includes the experience and education, no proof of education is required at bid closing. As stated in the Attachment 1 to Part 5, "Bidders are reminded to obtain the required equivalence promptly. Any delay in the award of a contract to allow the successful bidder to provide the required equivalence will be at the entire discretion of the Contracting Authority. "
