**Questions from bidders with response back from Public Works and Government Services Canada.**

**Q1.** As this is the third RFP iteration for this position, it is extremely difficult to locate a specific person with the skill requested in the RFP and in order to make the competition as open as possible, we request the mandatory requirements be amended to as follows:

MT6

*The proposed technician must have a minimum of three (3) months experience in the last ten (10) years calibrating and repairing torque wrenches.*

*1 As proof of compliance, the Bidder must provide a detailed resume for the proposed technicians', verifying required experience*

MT7

*The proposed technician must have a minimum of three (3) months experience in the last ten (10) years inputting data into the TEMMIS system.*

*As proof of compliance, the Bidder must provide a detailed resume for the proposed technicians', verifying required experience*

**A1.** MT6 and MT7 will be amended as follows:

**Refer:** Part 4 - Evaluation Procedures and Basis of Selection, 1.1.1. Mandatory Technical Criteria, MT6 and MT7

**Delete:** In its Entirety

**Insert:** Part 4 - Evaluation Procedures and Basis of Selection, 1.1.1. Mandatory Technical Criteria, MT6 and MT7

MT6	<p>The proposed technician must have a minimum of three (3) months experience in the last ten (10) years calibrating and repairing SNAP ON torque wrenches.</p> <p>As proof of compliance, the Bidder must provide an accreditation certificate from Snap On tools.</p>
MT7	<p>The proposed technician must have a minimum of three (3) months experience in the last ten (10) years inputting data into the TEMMIS system.</p> <p>As proof of compliance, at a minimum, the Bidder must provide a copy of the proposed technicians' resume, including dates to verify required experience.</p>

**Q2.** Re MT6 would the crown accept that the winning bidder commits to sending the resource to the necessary SNAP ON training if they also meet the mandatory requirement "three (3) months experience in the last three (3) years calibrating and repairing SNAP ON torque wrenches."

**A2.** We will not satisfy the proposed amendment to MT6.

**Q3.** Regarding MT4 would the crown accept a security clearance to secret from another GOC department? As we understand these clearances can be transferred to CIISD.

**A3.** In regards to your question 1, and as per the security requirement of the Supply Arrangement, the following applies:

**The Supplier must hold the following minimum security requirement in order to remain a Supplier. The Supply Arrangement Authority may verify the Supplier's security clearance with the Canadian and International Industrial Security Directorate (CIISD),**

**PWGSC at any time during the life of the Supply Arrangement.**

**SECURITY REQUIREMENT FOR CANADIAN SUPPLIER:**

**PWGSC FILE # E60ZH-070002SRCL2**

1. The Supplier must, at all times during the performance of the Supply Arrangement hold a valid Facility Security Clearance at the level of SECRET issued by the Canadian Industrial Security Directorate (CISD), Public Works and Government Services Canada (PWGSC).

2. The Supplier personnel requiring access to PROTECTED/CLASSIFIED information, assets or sensitive work site(s) must EACH hold a valid RELIABILITY or SECRET, granted or approved by CIISD/PWGSC.

3. The Supplier MUST NOT remove any PROTECTED/CLASSIFIED information or assets from the identified work site(s), and the Contractor/Offeror must ensure that its personnel are made aware of and comply with this restriction.

4. Subcontracts which contain security requirements are NOT to be awarded without the prior written permission of CIISD/PWGSC.

5. The Offeror shall comply with the provisions of:

- (a) The Security Requirements Check List (SRCL) E60ZH-070002SRCL2, described in Annex "B ";
- (b) The Industrial Security Manual (Latest Edition).

[Note to suppliers: In the case of Joint Ventures or Amalgamations, the highest level of corporate security attainable through CIISD of PWGSC is the lowest level held by any single member of the JV or amalgamation. For example: a Joint Venture with five (5) members is comprised of four members holding a valid Facility Security Clearance (FSC) at the Secret level and one member holding a valid Designated Organization Screening (DOS). The highest corporate security level for which the Joint Venture would be considered under this SA framework would be DOS, until such time as the member holding a valid DOS clearance has requested sponsorship via the Supply Arrangement Authority and obtained a valid FSC at the secret level issued by CIISD.]
