	Agriculture & Agri-Food Canada located in Lacombe, Alberta has a requirement for the supply and delivery of one (1) new 15 foot Swather (self-propelled windrower with a 15 foot header). The requested Swather will be used for cutting canola, variety of cereal crops, pulse plots and possibly other crops or forages. The plots are mainly 12 feet wide x 50 feet long. The size of the header is very important, since a 12 foot header would be too narrow to cut the crop and an 18 foot header would be too wide to fit between the different plots.
