AMENDMENT 001

The purpose of this amendment is to publish answers in response to questions received regarding this TBIPS SA RFP.

THE FOLLOWING CLARIFICATIONS FORM PART OF THIS TBIPS SA RFP:

Question 1) In section 7.8 (c) (ii) on page 25 of 31 – the Crown indicates that,

(ii) *Once Canada has paid the maximum TA price, Canada will not be required to make any further payment, but the Contractor must complete all the work described in the TA, all of which is required to be performed for the maximum TA price. If the work described in the TA is completed in less time than anticipated, and the actual time worked (as supported by the time sheets) at the rates set out in the Contract is less than the maximum TA price, Canada is only required to pay for the actual time spent performing the work related to that TA.*

It appears that the TAs would be a "Per Diem with a Ceiling" in which the vendor must complete all tasks and deliverables in order to achieve the maximum TA price, even if it requires working additional days than indicated in the TA. Yet if the TA is completed in less time, the vendor is only paid the days that are worked. Could the Crown please confirm that this understanding is correct?

Answer 1) No, your interpretation is incorrect. It is the intention of any resulting contract and TA called-up against it, to have the number of person-days of effort required to be supplied by the Project Authority and the vendor will be paid based on timesheets submitted and approved by the Project Authority. The description of the requirements from the SOW will be supplied by the Project Authority and the contractor is only responsible for providing the services of the proposed resource at the quoted per diem rate.

Question 2) Would HRSDC be willing to accept parental affiliate references in response to the mandatory and rated requirements?

Answer 2) For references to be accepted, the referenced project must have been contracted "at arm's length" with the Bidder, or the entity (individual firm or joint venture) as qualified under the TBIPS SA, in the categories included in this solicitation.
