This first solicitation amendment is raised to respond to a question and to revise some of the clauses.

1. In regards to the Sonar Mechanical R&O Solicitation W8482-120364/B, can you tell me if there are existing Repair and Test Schemes (RTS's) available for the proposed repairable items listed in Appendix 1 to Annex A?

The only repair schemes that DND have are in draft form only. These documents are not Canadian Forces Technical Orders and have not been identified in the Statement of Work (SOW) as "Applicable Documents" as they have not been validated. Most of the performance and reliability requirements (i.e. dimensions, pressure, force, torque etc.) are contained in the applicable drawings (part of the TDPs identified in para 4.6 of the SOW).

2. This is to notify Bidders that in order to be compliant the successful Bidder must have a facility located in the greater Halifax area or they must include a clear statement in their bid that they will establish a facility there before the work will commence.
3. In the Request For Proposal at Part 7 - Resulting Contract Clauses under 6. Payment, delete 6.7 Limitation of Expenditure in its entirety and substitute with the following:

6.6 Limitation of Expenditure

1. Canada's total liability to the Contractor under the Contract must not exceed \$2,429,500.00. Customs duties are included and Goods and Services Tax or Harmonized Sales Tax is extra, if applicable.
2. No increase in the total liability of Canada or in the price of the Work resulting from any design changes, modifications or interpretations of the Work, will be authorized or paid to the Contractor unless these design changes, modifications or interpretations have been approved, in writing, by the Contracting Authority before their incorporation into the Work. The Contractor must not perform any work or provide any service that would result in Canada's total liability being exceeded before obtaining the written approval of the Contracting Authority. The Contractor must notify the Contracting Authority in writing as to the adequacy of this sum:
 - a. when it is 75 percent committed, or
 - b. four (4) months before the contract expiry date, or
 - c. as soon as the Contractor considers that the contract funds provided are inadequate for the completion of the Work,

whichever comes first.
3. If the notification is for inadequate contract funds, the Contractor must provide to the Contracting Authority a written estimate for the additional funds required. Provision of such information by the Contractor does not increase Canada's liability.

4. In the Request For Proposal at Part 7 - Resulting Contract Clauses, delete clause 17. Performance and Reliability in its entirety.
