Modification 001

Mandatory M-10 is hereby modified as follow:

Bidder is not required to provide Criminal Record Verification Form (Form 5), within its bid response. Bidder must provide a properly completed and signed Consent to a Criminal Record Verification Form (Form 5), for each individual named if requested by the Contracting Authority. 2003 (2012-07-11) Standard Instructions - Goods or Services is hereby modified accordingly.

Modification 002

The text under Subsection 4 of Section 01 - Code of Conduct and Certifications of 2003 (2012-07-11) Standard Instructions - Goods or Services - Competitive Requirements is replaced by:

Bidders should provide, with their bid or promptly thereafter, a complete list of names of all individuals who are currently directors of the Bidder. If such a list has not been received by the time the evaluation of bids is completed, Canada will inform the Bidder of a time frame within which to provide the information. Failure to provide such a list within the required time frame will render the bid non-responsive. Bidders must always submit the list of directors before contract award.

Canada may, at any time, request that a Bidder provide properly completed and Signed Consent Forms (Consent to a Criminal Record Verification form - PWGSC-TPSGC 229) for any or all individuals named in the aforementioned list within a specified delay. Failure to provide such Consent Forms within the delay will result in the bid being declared non-responsive.

Modification No. 3

The text under Subsection 5 of Section 01 - Code of Conduct and Certifications of 2003 (2012-07-11) Standard Instructions - Goods or Services - Competitive Requirements is replaced by:

"The Bidder must diligently maintain the list up-to-date by informing Canada in writing of any change occurring during the validity period of the bid, and must also provide Canada, when requested, with the corresponding Consent Forms. The Bidder will also be required to diligently maintain the list and when requested, provide Consent Forms during the period of any contract arising from this bid solicitation."

QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS

Question 005

Question: Is it a requirement for web based application or desktop based?

Answer: As per answer to question #4 of Amendment 001 there is no requirement for the successful bidder to build or maintain a web-based application to access the data.

Question 006

Question: How the Data will be updated on regular basis ?

Answer: The successful bidder must provide Statistics Canada with a consolidated monthly updated file (in the required format as per the requirement outlined in the statement of Work).

Question 007

Question: How many users will use this application ?

Answer: As per answer to question #4 of Amendment 001 there is no requirement for the successful bidder to build or maintain a web-based application. Statistics Canada has a requirement for data to be provided electronically (flat file). There should be no limitation on the number of users who access the data. Please refer to the definition of "Entity License under the provisions of Supplemental General Conditions 4003.

Question 008

Question: What are the time lines of the project ?

Answer: The initial delivery of the data is required within thirty days of contract award. The data must then be delivered on a monthly basis.

Question 009

Question: Is there a fixed budget for this project ?

Answer: This is a competitive process. The responsive bid with the lowest evaluated price will be recommended for award of a contract.

Bidders should note that all contract awards are subject to Canada's internal approvals process, which includes a requirement to approve funding in the amount of any proposed contract. Despite the fact that the Bidder may have been recommended for contract award, a contract will only be awarded if internal approval is granted according to Canada's internal policies. If approval is not granted, no contract will be awarded.
