This Amendment No. 001 is hereby issued in response to questions raised on Solicitation No. 5P404-120366/A dated 2012-11-14.

Q1. Is there an option to build on top of existing concrete walls?

A1. As stated in the scope of work, Contractor must submit engineered drawings for the design of building. If building on top of existing concrete foundation, contractor must provide engineered stamp and approval that existing concrete foundation meets engineered specifications.

Q2. Can core sample be taken from existing concrete foundation?

A2. Permitted. Contractor must repair foundation after core sample is taken. All costs for core sampling and repairs is responsibility of Contractor.

Q3. Can we build walls from 2x6 versus 2x8?

A3. If 2x6 walls are engineered as is required in the scope of work, R28 insulation value in walls must be met.

Q4. What type of building was removed from existing foundation?

A4. Wood structure "A" Frame design. (Round Roof Shed). Wood laminated beams. 3/4" shiplap on roof covered with metal roofing.

Q5. Are suppliers responsible for the building permit for the structure?

A5. No. A business license is required by the Contractor before commencing construction. Cost of business license is \$100. and cost is responsibility of Contractor. The license can be purchased at the Administration Building in RMNP

Additional comments made by Parks Canada were:

Access to work site would be given to successful contractor for after regular hours.
Electrical power supplied to Contractor by Parks Canada for duration of Contract.
