Questions:

Q3 Why is Canada only specifying Disposal at Sea (DaS)? Is Canada open to other methods of disposal? Why not leave it to the contractor to decide if it is more cost effective to land dispose of the material?

A3 All dredged material is to be disposed of at sea as specified.

Q4 We are questioning the change in the Disposal at Sea (DaS) permit for Meteghan in the 2013. In 2012 the DaS permit did not specify the types of equipment to be utilized in the execution of the work and we note the 2013 DaS permit does specify the equipment and the method of execution. Why is Canada specifying the equipment for disposal? Is Canada open to other methods of executing the work?

A4 The changes to the disposal at sea permit were initiated by Environment Canada. The disposal equipment specified in the ocean disposal permit is based on the environmental assessment and disposal site modeling data which will govern for this contract.

Q5 Why is Canada specifying Disposal at Sea (DaS) with bottom dump scows when there are other types of equipment available to complete the work as per the DaS permit?

A5 Refer to A4.

Q6. Is PWGSC and this tender calling bound by Canada's Agreement on Internal Trade and the Treasury Boards Contracting policy?

A6 This procurement is subject to the Agreement on Internal Trade and the Treasury Board Contracting Policy do apply.

Q7 Is the warranty period of one year will start at the acceptance of the installation in 2013 or it will start only after the date he will be paid in 2014 ?

A7 The warranty would start the year the work is accepted.
