## Solicitation Amendment No. 3

### Questions and Answers Set No. 3

**Question No. 1:** On page 12 of the RFP, under Customer Reference Contact Information, the RFP states that "The Bidder must provide customer references who must each confirm when requested by PWGSC, the facts identified in the Bidder's proposal". Can you please confirm whether we need to provide a customer reference for each of the projects we use within our proposal for each proposed resource?

**Response No. 1:** Yes, you need to provide a customer reference for each of the projects we use within our proposal for each proposed resource.

**Question No. 2:** On page 58 of the RFP document, under A.6 Programmer/Software Developer, R2 states that the proposed resource should have experience "working with simple and advanced workflow techniques". Would the Crown be able to provide an example of a simple workflow technique and an example of an advanced workflow technique?

**Response No. 2:** Example of simple workflow techniques would be swim lanes as constructed with a tool similar to MS Visio. Advanced would be workflows done using a Business Process Modeling software that define complex workflows within an organisation.

**Question No. 3:** To properly substantiate our candidate's experience, qualifications and expertise, please confirm it is acceptable to cross-reference to detailed project descriptions in his/her resume. The projects in the resume will be sequentially numbered and that number will be used in the matrix to identify the relevant projects that substantiate the specific requirement. Each project in the resume will include department, project name, role and start/end dates, the candidate's responsibilities and activities as well as an annotation that reflects the mandatory or rated criteria that each statement in the resume is supporting. For example, in response to mandatory criteria M1, a (M1) could be placed at the beginning of the statement in the resume that satisfies this criteria.

**Response No. 3:** Acceptable.

**Question No. 4:** On page 58 of the RFP document, for the Programmer/Software Developer, Level 2, Criteria R1 asks for "Demonstrated experience with PHP (version 5.3.3 or greater) and MySQL (version 5.1 or greater) development". Since PHP version 5.3.3 was only released in July of 2010, it is very difficult for a candidate to score full points on this criteria since they would need 3 projects since July 2010 with PHP version 5.3.3, all of which must be 6 months or more in duration. Would the Crown consider amending this criteria to include PHP versions 5 and greater?

**Response No. 4:** Agreed. The A.6 Programmer/Software Developer, Level 2 rated evaluation criteria now reads as follows:
