Q1. Item 2 - What kind of floor covering will it be - Carpet, Ceramic, Vinyl, etc.

A1. All types

Q2. Item 3 - What kind of underlay? chip form, cork; Glue down or floating

A2. The underlay to be removed can be all types, and may be floating, glue down or nail down. Please refer to amended Annex B Basis of Payment, Pricing Basis A and Pricing Basis B included herein.

Q3. Item 7 - Is this carpet to be installed on top of chip form underlay? If yes, who will supply the underlay?

A3. The carpet is not normally installed on top of chip form underlay. The contractor will be responsible to supply any required underlayment.

Q4. Items 7 to 15 - Installation on wood substrate is different from Concrete substrate. Is it possible to make provision for two different prices for each items, i.e. (1) price for wood substrate & (2) price for concrete substrate

Q5. Item 15 - Rubber floor comes in many different thickness. Installation price is based on the thickness. What thickness you want us to price.
