2. At 1.2 Project Description and History, add the following:

TLICHO LAND CLAIM AND SELF-GOVERNMENT AGREEMENT:

The area of the contract is within the Môwhi Gogha Dè Nîitâèè area, as defined in the Tlicho Land Claims and Self-Government Agreement, and proximity to Yellowknife and Akaitcho Dene First Nation Communities of Dettah and N'dilo.

The requirements of the Tlicho Land Claim and Self Government Agreement will apply to this procurement. The benefits that apply are contained in: Chapter 26, the Tlicho Land Claim and Self Government Agreement, clauses 26.3, 26.3.1 (a).

3. At 2.5.3 Post-Qualification Conference, add the following:

The Roaster Complex has been identified as a Restricted Area as per the Northwest Territories & Nunavut Codes of Practice "Asbestos Abatement" (May 2012). Hygiene air monitoring has been conducted during investigation activities within the Roaster Complex and it was determined that airborne concentrations of asbestos and arsenic exceeded the legislated OELs. Contractors entering the Roaster Complex during the scheduled Contractor Walkthrough will be required don appropriate respiratory protective equipment and personal protective equipment for exposures to concentrations of asbestos and arsenic above the applicable OEL (Occupational Exposure Limits).

Contractor's entering the Roaster Complex are required to use the on Site decontamination trailer, provide proof of respirator fit testing, and worker training that complies with the Northwest Territories & Nunavut Codes of Practice "Asbestos Abatement" (May 2012). Training must be appropriate for the level of worker involvement including work procedures and worker decontamination procedures appropriate for working in a Restricted Area (i.e. 2-day Occupational Health and Safety for the Asbestos Worker). Two day worker courses provided by accredited agencies in the Northwest Territories, Ontario, British Columbia, and Alberta will be accepted

NOTE: Training/Certification will be confirmed/verified prior to any individual entering the Roaster complex.

4. At 2.3.2e Limitation of Submissions, add the following:

The Phase Two portion of the proposal must be made in the same name as the person(s) or entity(ies) named as the Proponent in the Phase One portion.

5. At Appendix "E" Checklist:

Delete: "Submit letter from Insurer for *Professional* liability Insurance coverage (3.3.2 (D))"

Insert: "Submit letter from Insurer for *Automobile* liability Insurance coverage (3.3.2 (D))"

6. At 2.3.3. Format of the Phase One Proposal:

Delete:

"Proposal should not exceed thirty (30) pages single side or fifteen (15) double sided). After an introductory page or letter stating the interest of the proponent concerning this project, the proponent must provide the Mandatory Requirements (Refer to Part 3.3 and Appendix B and C) and Rated Requirements (refer to Part 3.4 and Appendix D). Note an additional page for each project is allowed, but not required. The Mandatory Requirements and the Client Reference letters will not count in the total number of pages."

Insert:

"Proposals must not exceed thirty (30) pages single side or fifteen (15) double sided). After an introductory page or letter stating the interest of the proponent concerning this project, the proponent must provide the Mandatory Requirements (Refer to Part 3.3 and Appendix B and C) and Rated Requirements (refer to Part 3.4 and Appendix D). The Mandatory Requirements and the Client Reference letters will not count in the total number of pages.

Any pages which extend beyond the above page limitation and any other attachments will be extracted from the proposal and will not be forwarded to the PWGSC Evaluation Board members for evaluation."

7. Questions and Answers:

Q1. Can the bidder's proposed main sub-contractors project summaries and letters of reference be used? Will they carry weighting equal to the summaries and letters of reference submitted for projects completed directly by the General Contractor.

A1. Yes.

Q2. The security deposit can be in the form of a standby letter of credit in an amount that is equal to not less than 20% of the Contract Amount (as seen in GC9), however GI09 states the following:

The bidder shall submit a bid security with the bid in the form of a bid bond or a security deposit in an amount that is equal to not less than 10% of the bid amount. The maximum amount of bid security required with any bid is \$2 million. We are requesting clarification on which % amount is correct.

A2. Bid security is at **10%** of the bid price, up to a maximum of \$2 million. This bid bond or security deposit, must be submitted with the Proposal.

Contract security is at **20%** of the contract value if provided in the form of a standby letter of credit.

Otherwise, contract security is to be provided at 100% of contract value, in the form of a 50% Performance bond and a 50% Labour and Material bond. Contract security is to be submitted within 14 days notice of the successful bidder being notified in writing of their success.
