AMENDMENT 001

This amendment is raised to answer questions.

Q1: How much money does DND plan to spend on crane rentals over the next two years? Approximately how much was spent on crane rentals in the previous 2 years?

A1: The estimated spending over the next two years is \$100,000.00 as stated in the document. In previous 2 years, approx. \$15,000.00 have been spent on crane rentals.

Q2: What is the age limitation for equipment? Is this age requirement applicable for every machine or is this a fleet average? Since the DND asks for prices for conventional cranes sizes that have not been manufactured in 30 years, are there exceptions to the age requirement?

A2: As long as the vendor can provide proof of a valid Non Destructive Testing (NDT) certificate that would be acceptable.

Q3: Under "Basis of Payment" there is a list of crane sizes for offerors to quote their prices. Does the base require these exact sizes of crane or will a 60 ton hydraulic meet the needs of the DND rather than the 65 ton hydraulic crane which is being asked for and so forth, 110 ton hydraulic crane rather than the 120 ton, etc.

A3: The 65 Ton and 120 Ton were requested primarily due to lift requirements and boom radius. A lower tonnage would not meet the lift and boom radius requirements depending on the job. The requested cranes sizes will remain.

Q4: Since no crane company on the Island owns every piece of equipment being asked for, is it required that applicants meet every crane requirement of the DND or does the DND allow re-rentals to other crane companies which may have the required piece of equipment?

A4: Subcontracting in the past did not work out the best. If agreed, all applicable requirements must be met by the subcontractor/sub-rented equipment.
