Q-3 Under section 2.2.1, Video File Specifications on pages 30 and 31 of the RFP, it states that the Preservation file shall be a J2K stream in an MXF format...(I'm paraphrasing) and that the access (proxy) files should be H.264 in MP4 file format at 2 Mbps.

No mention is made of WMV files in this section.

However, on page 32, under section 2.2.4, File Directory Structure, it mentions "All files created during the digitization...

..."vault shelf#" .wmv as a low resolution proxy file

This is in addition to the mxf and mp4 file.

Are WMV files required to be created for each videotape?

A-3 We had made a decision to drop the requirement for .wmv files to be created. All references to .wmv files should have been removed.. We do not require the creation of this file type and the reference in section 2.2.4 on page 32 should be removed.
