This amendment is being raised to make revision to RS1.3 Site Inspection and provide responses to Requests for Clarification.

Revision to RS1.3 SITE INSPECTION

1. FIELD INSPECTION AND RECORDS

RS1.3.1 (a)(v)

Delete:

In its entirety

Insert:

(v) A detailed mechanical **and electrical** inspection, to verify condition, reliability and functionality of the components of the dam, including but not limited to:

- (1) Hydraulic log lifter and back-up manual winches.
- (2) Vertical steel roller gates and operating machinery.
- (3) Radial-arm gates and operating machinery.
- (4) Electrical wiring and installations are to be reviewed and inspected to assess code compliance, including but not limited to limit switches, control panels, MCC controls, electrical motors and wiring, including amperage testing of motors (including measuring rush current on motors at start-up), and gate and gain heaters.**

RS1.3.1 (a)(ix)

Delete:

In its entirety

Insert:

(ix) Plans, drawings, and photographs as appropriate shall be prepared to document the location, type, and extent of deterioration and/or problem areas. The Consultant shall identify the probable cause or causes of such deterioration (e.g. freeze thaw action, ice damage, seepage, alkali-silica reaction, settlement, etc.). Mechanical **and electrical** deficiencies are also to be documented on the plans and drawings, with supporting photographs.

Requests for Clarification

Q21. The RFP for the completion of Dam Safety Reviews for the lower Rice Region does not contain much detail as to the requirements for the electrical engineer. Would it be possible to have more details outlined in the scope of work to address the expectations of the electrical engineer during the course of this project? i.e. which electrical components require inspection as part of this work?

A21. Please see Revision to RS 1.3.1 above.

Q22. I would like to request an extension of ten (10) calendar days for the above noted procurement.
Due to changes within the Amendment received today, it will be difficult to meet the deadline of July 4, 2013. Would there be any possibility that PWGSC would consider extending this procurement?

A22. No. The closing date will not be extended.

Q23. What area do the DTM files cover (i.e., just in the immediate areas of the sites or the entire river reach from Campbellford to the Bay of Quinte) ?

A23. The DTM files in the DVDs cover the immediate areas of the sites. Should the entire river reach from Campbellford to the Bay of Quinte be needed, they will be provided to the successful proponent.

Q24. Could you please provide further clarification regarding your answer to question # Q6. Does "back-up" refer to alternate Senior Specialists if the 2 key specialists can not fulfill the role for any reason or does "back-up" refer to less senior engineers (i.e., junior and intermediate engineers) that will be working on the DSRs under the guidance of the Senior Specialists. How many "back-up" personnel are we to identify per discipline?

**A.24 It is up to the consultant to decide the "back-up" they want to provide.
Only one back up is required for SRE 3.1.2.1(1)(ii) Lead Engineer.
Only one back up is required for each Key Sub-Consultants and/or Specialists discipline in SRE 3.1.2.1(2)(i) through to (vi).**

All other terms and conditions remain the same.
