This amendment number one (01) is raised to respond to bidder questions and to amend the Basis of Payment structure:

1. Question:

A topographical survey was undertaken of both the East and West dams by Parks during the 2012 engineering inspection. Is undertaking of a topographical survey of the dams (RS 3.3 g) to be including in the 2013 Dam Safety Review scope of work?

Answer:

Yes. The 2012 surveys are very rudimentary. A proper survey is still required and is to be included in the Dam Safety Review for both dams.

2. Question:

A typical approach for undertaking engineering assignments and preparing documentation for Dam Safety Reviews is on a per reservoir basis. Would only one Dam Safety Review report; Operation, Maintenance and Surveillance Manual; Emergency Preparedness Plan; and Emergency Response Plan covering both the East and West dams be acceptable?

Answer:

Yes, this approach is acceptable so long as each dam is identified separately in the report and all issues noted in the report are identified for each dam individually.

3. Annex B – Basis of Payment of tender 5P420-13-5029/A is deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following amended annex. Bidders must submit their financial bid in accordance with the revised Annex B – Basis of Payment on the following page of this amendment number one (01).

- (a) Each item will be used to amend the Contract should it be deemed by the Project Authority through the progress of the Work that a particular item is no longer required or an optional service is required.
- (b) Implementation of the detailed field investigation program will be managed as an amendment to the Contract and the costs are not to be included for the purposes of this proposal.
- (c) Assessing the earthquake parameter will be managed as an amendment to the Contract and the costs are not to be included for the purposes of this proposal.
- (d) Parks Canada makes the assumption that the EPP will have to be prepared based on the current Dam Classification.
- (e) Prices must appear in the financial bid only. No prices must be indicated in any other section of the bid.
- (f) Bidders must submit their financial bid in accordance with the Basis of Payment.
- (g) Customs duties are included and Goods and Services Tax or Harmonized Sales Tax is extra, if applicable.
