This solicitation amendment number two (002) is issued to provide answers to questions from potential Bidders, and replace the bid and acceptance form (BA) as follows:

Q1. Asphalt removal bid quantity is 30 m<sup>2</sup>. The cut shown on the drawings is 15 m x 4 m = 60 m<sup>2</sup>?

A1. Quantities for items 1, 2, 7 and 8 are updated in the new bid and acceptance form

Q2. Concrete invert lining bid quantity is 26 m<sup>3</sup>. Culvert under TCH is only 25 m long and end area of concrete is 0.14 m<sup>3</sup>/m = 3.50 m<sup>3</sup>?

A2 Quantity updated in the new bid and acceptance form.

Q3. Asphalt concrete pavement bid quantity is 35 tonnes. Replacing 60 m<sup>2</sup> @ 150 mm (0.36 tpm) = 21.6 tonnes?

A3. Asphalt quantity is correct

Q4. What are the reinforcing strap lengths for the MSE wall?

A4. Existing wall strap length is not known. Based on wall height a strap length of approximately 3 m is expected.

Q5. What are the thicknesses of the asphalt, base and sub-base gravels?

A5. Depths of asphalt, base and sub-base are to match existing thickness and will therefore be determined in the field.
