This Amendment 003 to Solicitation M4000-400135 is raised to respond to supplier questions and modify the solicitation as follows:

Supplier Questions:

Q11. There is no breakdown of what is required for a 66% submission. Was this an omission or is there not to be a 66% submission.

A11. Please refer to solicitation modifications below.

Q12. Must we have an acoustic specialist with credentials or can this be done by the architect? If you are only looking for STC rated assemblies an architect can do this work.

A12. The function of acoustic specialist could be performed by the Architect. This is at the discretion of the Proponent.

Q13. Do we need a cost specialist with credentials or can our engineers and architects do the estimates?

A13. Yes, a cost specialist is required.

Q14. Do you have a cost breakdown for the \$ 4,000,000 construction cost that we can see?

A14. No, this cost is an estimate to indicate the order of magnitude of cost.

Q15. Are the CVs included in the page count of 40 pages?

A15. No, CV's are not included in page count.

Q16. Is it mandatory to have an Acoustic Consultant or can this be determined if/when needed as the project progresses.

A16. Please refer to Question 13 above.

Q17. Appendix A (Team Identification form) missing Cost Consultant section – should we be including the Cost consultant in this form?

A17. Yes.

Q18. From Amendment 001 it states: “Q4. Please clarify, under rated requirements, 4.2.1, “Past Achievements of Key Sub-Consultants and Specialists” where you ask to “Select two projects undertaken to the construction . . .” does that allow for two projects from each sub-consultant (of which there may be many)? A4. No, we are looking for two projects by the Prime Consultants only.”

So sub consultants don't need to provide any info about past projects they have done? So only 2 projects from prime consultant and no projects from sub consultants? 4.2.2 states that we need the same information for the sub-consultants that we provided for the prime consultants.

A18. The two projects provided in the proposal should be limited to the Prime, Mechanical, and Electrical consultants.
