Please find attached three questions posed by potential bidders and their accompanying responses:

Q7) In reference to solicitation 14-74660, would it be possible to submit a bid for only the English component of the language training?

A7) Unfortunately no.

Q8) Would there be any consideration for a Software/Technology base program to fulfill the requirement for language acquisition? Our program is currently being used by dozens of Canadian Government offices helping in the development of needed language skills. We also have the capability of delivering instructor led training on-line.

A8) The department is already using an online tool, Tell Me More from Auralog to develop/maintain the two official languages of its employees. The teachers will be asked to promote this tool so the employees could use it during the training period and after this period as well.

Q9) We are about to hire teachers with a secret security clearance but at the moment the security clearance does not belong to the teachers but rather to the school that is making the request. Would you be willing to temporarily accept instructors with a reliability status clearance while waiting for the secret clearance to be issued?

A9) Unfortunately, the current required security clearance level for access to 111 and 125 Sussex is secret and all instructors will need to have a valid secret security clearance upon bid submission.
