Please be advised that CMHC is amending Article 5.4 of the Request For Proposal (RFP) document as follows:

At Article 5.4

Delete: the fourth paragraph in its entirety, and in lieu thereof

Insert:

Each compliant proposal that meets the minimum upset scores in each category shall then be evaluated using the "greatest score" methodology. Under this approach, the proponent receiving the highest score in the Pricing Proposal criteria is not necessarily the lead proponent.

A minimum of the top two (2) proponents with the highest overall scores may be shortlisted and invited to participate in an oral presentation. The final overall scores for each proponent will then be confirmed and the proponent with the highest overall score will be deemed to be the lead proponent with whom CMHC will enter into negotiations.

ALL OTHER TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF THE RFP WILL REMAIN UNCHANGED
