This Amendment 001 is raised to respond to the following bidder questions:

Question 1:

Are there any conditions in regard to location that data is hosted, other than the requirement for it to be held in two separate places? If there are any conditions, what are they?

Answer 1:

No, there are no other requirements regarding the physical location of the Bidders Data Centres. As indicated in the Statement of Work, The Bidder's data centres should have presence in two different geographic areas to reduce the risk of service impacts (requirement 1.3.1.4), and the processes used to manage the Bidder's Data Centre should be ISO 9000 (process) certified. The proposal should include evidence to substantiate any ISO 9000 or equivalent certifications (requirement 1.3.1.3).

Question 2:

What is the planned service commencement date?

Answer 2:

The Correctional Service of Canada (CSC) anticipates receiving its Electronic Monitoring equipment in March 2014 in order to complete training activities and operational checkout, prior to the expected launch of the Electronic Monitoring Pilot in April 2014.

Question 3:

In the previous pilot, what was the average length of time that an offender wore a device?

Answer 3:

The average length of time that an offender wear a EM device for was 74 days.

Question 4:

For this pilot, what is the anticipated average period of time that an offender will wear a device?

Answer 4:

As each individual case is dependent upon a multitude of factors, such as conditions imposed by the Parole Board of Canada and the assessment of risk by the case management team, CSC can not anticipate what the average period of time that an offender will wear a device for will be.

Question 5:

In the pricing schedule there are three elements, per device per day, expert witness per diem and each additional training course. These are repeated for each of the three periods. How are the three elements combined in the price evaluation?

Answer 5:

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Question 6:

(Ref: Page 13 - 2.2.1.1) In regard to the accuracy level of 150m 90% of the time, is this purely using the cellular signal that is referred to. In what geographical situations does this refer to?

Answer 6:

This criterion will be evaluated as part of Testing Scenario 7 Accuracy GPS/GPS Assisted Tracking (page 33 of Demonstration and Testing Scenarios document). The accuracy level of 150m 90% of the time will be tested using only the cellular signal.

CSC will position two EM devices, provided by the Bidder, in a residential wooden structure both above (upstairs) and below (basement) grade for a predetermined length of time. The accuracy testing will be conducted between the hours of 9:30 am ET and 5:30 pm ET and consist of three periods of 1 hour each. These tests will be conducted in either Ottawa, Ontario or Kingston, Ontario.

CSC will contact the Bidder immediately prior to the start of the GPS Assisted Tracking Testing to confirm that the two EM devices are fully functional and are currently gathering data points via the cellular network and not GPS.
