	Question	Answer
1.	What is the difference between "Certified" and "Trained" upper air observer? The reference is on page 9 of the RFP.	Once an observer is trained by EC and/or the site manager/contractor, he/she must be certified at the specific site by an EC representative. In order for a trained observer to maintain certification, he/she must perform a full flight at least once every 60 days. I would suggest that the bidder should refer to page 27-28 of the package.
2.	The RFP still references HST for British Columbia on page 8.	The clause will be corrected on the "Buy & Sell" tender website.
3	Can you clarify if Environment Canada is exempt from the current PST in BC?	BC is subject to GST. The Federal Government is PST exempted.
