

## **Amendment 1 to Request for Proposal (RFP) 1000148022**

Amendment 1 is raised to answer the following:

Q1 Mandatory Requirement 1 of the RFP states that a Senior Researcher must have completed Nurse-Family Partnership (NFP) training at the National Service office. Must training be complete at the time the bid is submitted or can training be completed at a later date, prior to the initiation of the project?

A1 The training must be in place at the time the proposal is submitted.

Q2 Mandatory Requirement 3 of the RFP states that a minimum of one of the resources on the proposed team must have an agreement with Dr. David Olds and/or the Prevention Research Center of Family and Child Health, University of Colorado Denver in order to access and use the copy written NFP material. Must this agreement be in place at the time the bid is submitted or can an agreement be put in place at a later date, prior to the initiation of the project?

A2 The agreement must be in place when the proposal is submitted.

Q3 Could you advise on the expected start date for the contract?

A3 The expected start date and other anticipated timelines for the work to be completed as part of the contract can be found in section 2.1 of Appendix A of the Statement of Work of the Draft Contract.

Q4 The Contract labelled “Long Form Contract for Services” is labelled as “Draft”. Is this a normal procedure or is a final version is available?

A5 The document is labelled as “Draft” presently as all information is not presently know (eg. contractor, exact start date, Contract dollar amount, etc.).
