QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS

Question 1:

Is it possible to change the technical criteria in section 2.3.7 UNDERWATER LIGHTS? We can use different matrices in our products but with the color of 5600K has the best characteristics for imaging. The color temperature of 5500K is the standard of a daylight balanced film for reproduction (daylight-balanced standard photographic film) temperature.

Can section 2.3.7 for the Color Temperature be modified to 5600K or greater?

Answer 1:

Yes, this criterion can be modified.
