This amendment is raised to answer the following:

Q5: Can you clarify how you would eliminate or what steps you take to eliminate the presence of live ammunition or rounds in the waste streams or containers?

A5: On all three ranges after every shooting session a visual inspection is done to make sure any live rounds are picked and properly put away. Custodial also does a visual inspection to make sure there are no live rounds prior to cleaning any part of the range including the bullet traps and if one is found they place it in an amnesty box located on each range. Custodial do not clean the back of the ranges behind the bullet traps so there is no visual inspections done by them in those areas and no one is to be back there except for maintenance purposes.
