Amendment No. 001

The purpose of this amendment No. 001 is to:

- 1 – Amend the solicitation document at PART 4 – EVALUATION PROCEDURES;
- 2 – Inform bidders that within all Call 004 French Solicitation documents, the term “volet régulier” conveys “volet standard”;
- 3 – Amend the French Solicitation document at PART 4 – EVALUATION PROCEDURES, under Article 2.1 Stage One – Mandatory Requirements, at “Phase 3 – Stage One Debriefing” & under Article 2.2 Stage Two – Point Rated Criteria, at “Phase 7 – Stage 2 Debriefing”;
- 4 – Correct the website link at PART 3 – PROPOSAL PREPARATION INSTRUCTIONS, under Article 5. Certifications;
- 5 – Correct the website link at PART 1 – GENERAL INFORMATION, under Article 2. Policy Statements; &
- 6 – Insert Attachment A – Questions and Answers to the Call for Proposals Solicitation document and respond to questions received by bidders.

1 – At PART 4 – EVALUATION PROCEDURES of the Solicitation document, under 2.2 Stage Two – Point Rated Criteria“, at Phase 6 Pre-Qualified Pool:

Q1 Can you clarify if one’s innovations are directly usable by the Government of Canada or if there is a way for federally funded institutions to participate.

A1 It is up to the Bidder to determine if their innovation is suitable for the Program. All bidders may submit a proposal and efforts will be made to find a Testing Department match for proposals in the Pool of Pre-Qualified Proposals. While the Call for Proposals does cover a broad range of goods and services, there may be proposed innovations for which a Testing Department match will not exist.

Testing Departments are identified in Schedule I, I.1 and II of the *Financial Administration Act*. The testing could take place at a third party location if it falls within the mandate of the Testing Department.

Q2 We have another spin-off technology which was developed here but the licensee is an American company and development is taking place in Vancouver and Seattle. Can we submit this innovation?

A2 The Bidder must be the owner of the Intellectual Property (IP) for the proposed innovation, or have a licence to the IP rights from a Canadian licensor for the proposed innovation and not infringe on any IP rights.

Q3 Is the date for the next BCIP Call for Proposals known?

R3 The next BCIP Call for Proposals has not been announced yet.

Q4 Where is the electronic submission form?

A4 The link for the electronic submission form can be found at PART 3 – PROPOSAL PREPARATION INSTRUCTIONS, under 1. Electronic Proposal Submission Form of the Solicitation document.

Q5 What is the meaning of the Goods and Services Identification Number (GSIN) on the Solicitation page?

A5 The federal government uses GSIN codes to identify generic product descriptions for its procurement activities. On Buyandsell.gc.ca, GSIN codes connect all of the procurement information.

For the BCIP, the GSINS are shown for information purposes only. Your Innovation must fall under the Priority Areas in order to respect the Mandatory Criteria of the Program. The Call 004 Priority Areas are:

Standard Component:

- Environment;
- Safety & Security;
- Health; &
- Enabling Technology.

Military Component:

- Protecting the Soldier.
