Identifying the specific rail gauge, such as GIC, the amount of time allowed for preparation, such as 4 hours with two personnel, and the equipment allowed, such as using only equipment carried on the vehicle, would transform this into a valid and verifiable requirement.</p> <p>Suggested phrasing:</p> <p>"The vehicle shall fit within the GIC diagram IAW MIL-STD-1366E.
