This amendment number two (02) is raised to respond to bidder questions and to amend the *Specifications* accordingly:

1. Question:

Underlay – the *Specifications* asks for 30 lb. felt. Is Rino Tough acceptable?

Answer:

A 30 lb. Asphalt shingle felt underlay with slip sheet (per the *Specifications*) is required. In accordance with *GI15 (2007-05-25) Approval of Alternate Materials of R2710T (2013-06-27) General Instructions to Bidders*: “During the solicitation period, alternative materials may be considered provided full technical data is received in writing by the Contracting Officer at least ten (10) calendar days prior to the solicitation closing date.” General Instructions to Bidders are incorporated by reference and is set out in the Standard Acquisition Clauses and Conditions (SACC) Manual, issued by Public Works and Government Services Canada (PWGSC). The SACC Manual is available on the PWGSC Web site:

2. Question:

The *Specifications* call for 814 mm (32”) wide sheets. The product is available in 12”, 14” and 21” max panels. The 32” panel is not available. Please advise.

Answer:

Metal roofing panels 12”, 14”, or 21” in width will be acceptable in lieu of 32” (814 mm) wide panels.

3. Question:

The *Specifications* indicate that “Contractor and sub-contractors to apply for business licenses to work inside National Parks and apply for vehicle permits.” Elk Island National Park has indicated that this is not a requirement for performing work inside the Park. Please clarify.

Answer:

National Park business licenses and vehicle permits are not required. Removed per amendment item 4. Below.

- .1 Contractor and sub-contractors to apply for Business Licences to work inside National Parks and apply for vehicle permits.
