On page 10 of 56, SELECTION AND EVALUATION CRITERIA, M3

Delete:

Each of the resource(s) proposed by the Bidder must include two (2) client references, correct and up-to-date, that attest to their private investigation experience within the last four years. The additional references will be assessed per Rated Evaluation Criteria R-2.

Replace with:

Each of the resource(s) proposed by the Bidder must include two (2) client references, listing correct and up to date contact information only, that can attest to their private investigation experience within the last four years. The additional references will be assessed per Rated Evaluation Criteria R-2.

On page 10 of 56, SELECTION AND EVALUATION CRITERIA

Insert the following mandatory requirement as M7

All bidders must be in compliance with their provincial licensing statutes and are required to provide copies of their valid provincial private investigator licenses.

On page 11 of 56, Rated Requirements, R-2

Delete:

The resource(s) proposed by the Bidder provides positive client references, related to private investigations that can attest to their private investigation experience.

Replace with:

The resource(s) proposed by the Bidder provides client references, listing correct and up to date contact information only, that can attest to their private investigation experience.

On page 5 of 56, Bidders Recourse 10.2

Delete:

10.2 in the case of procurements subject to the Agreement on Internal Trade (AIT), the North American Free Trade Agreement (NAFTA), the World Trade Organization - Agreement on Government Procurement (WTO-AGP), the Canada - Chile Free Trade Agreement (CCFTA) or the Canada - Peru Free Trade Agreement (CPFTA), unsuccessful bidders have the right to file a written complaint with the Canadian International Trade Tribunal; and/or
