This amendment is raised to answer questions from suppliers and to change Part 5 – Certifications of the Request for Proposals.

Questions and Answers

Q34: In reference to Part 5, article 2.2, please share the policy related to the Canadian Content Certification required from bidders?

R34: Part 5, article 2.2 references Annex 3.6 of the Supply Manual, to which all bidders have access. The entire Annex (3.6) explains the Canadian Content Policy. Articles 2, 3 and 7 therein detail its application relative to this requirement.

In parallel, PWGSC is applying the Policy in line with the provisions of the Procurement Strategy for Aboriginal Business. Part 5, article 2.3 references Annex 9.4 of the Supply Manual to which all bidders have access. Within this Annex, article 9.40.15 (c) indicates the application of the Canadian Content Policy.

Q35: If there is no policy for the application of Canadian Content, why not remove it from this solicitation?
