AMENDMENT 002

This amendment is raised in response to the following.

Question 1: Annex A, Section 2.5. Our furniture is certified Greenguard and Greenguard Gold. Will Canada accept this green certification as equivalent to eh ANSI/BIFMA e3-2011e or SCS-EC-10.2-1007 environmental requirements?

Answer 1: Yes, Greenguard and Greenguard Gold certification is acceptable. Please note that a copy of the certification from ANSI/BIFMA, SCS, Greenguard or Greenguard Gold must accompany the bid packages.

Question 2: Annex A, Section 6.1.3. Minimum height range is 648mm (25.5") to 1066mm (42"). Our range is 648mm (25.5") to 1041mm (41"). Will a 41"H maximum height be acceptable to Canada for this project?

Answer 2: 1041mm (41") will be acceptable as the Maximum height.

Question 3: Annex A, Section 6.1.6. Table tops and keyboard trays to be a minimum of 28.6mm (1-1/8") thick to a maximum of 38.1mm (1.5") thick. We offer 1-1/16" (27mm) thick and 38mm (1.5") surfaces. Would a 27mm (1-1/16") thick surface be acceptable to Canada for this project?

Answer 3: 27mm (1-1/16") will be an acceptable thickness as long as the finish is high pressure laminate.

Question 4: Annex A, Section 6.1.6. 3mm thick flat PVC edge trim. Our edge trim is ABS plastic, which is more environmentally friendly (no chloride). Will this be acceptable to Canada for this project?

Answer 4: Edge must be PVC.

Question 5: Annex A, Section 6.1.6. Grommets to match table cover. Our grommets consist of a grommet insert and a grommet cover. Are you simply stating that the grommet cover must match the grommet insert? If so, no problem - this is standard. However, if you are asking for the grommet cover to match the laminate finish of the table top, this will not be possible. Grommet covers are not available in high-pressure laminate finishes; we offer black, silver, or anthracite grey. Will this be acceptable to Canada?

Answer 5: Grommet finish colour to match or compliment the table colour. Grommet does not have to be HPL

Question 6: Annex B, section 6 . Tentative installation start dates are subject to change. Phase 1 tentatively starts on February 1, 2014, which is less than 3 weeks after the bid opening date. We would not be able to deliver under 4 weeks (20 business days) after placement of order. This would only affect Phase 1. Please advise if this is acceptable to Canada.

Answer 6: If bidder cannot meet the tentative delivery date bidder can submit an alternate date. See column J of Table II - Delivery

Question 7: If we offer the same crank style table for this product will it be acceptable as far as meeting all other specs?

Answer 7: Crank Height adjustable can be submitted in place of pin height adjustable.

All other terms and conditions remain unchanged.
