



Question(s) and Answer(s) 2

Q1. We feel that this study would be most suitable for human subjects, and not either worms or mice. Our study would be most useful for humans travelling to other worlds (whether the Moon or Mars or others) and relates to medical assessment of human subjects.

A1. The Canadian Space Agency has always supported space research in relation to human health and will soon propose other opportunities to perform studies using human subjects.
