Question:

Although it says one standing offer will be issued to one company, I believe there is no restriction on bidding. Is this the case? I mean I can source the accommodation, the vehicles and of course the fuel as well. To clarify, my question was if I can bid to all standing offers or just one? For example, if I bid for the AMSE offer, can I still bid for the hotel and vehicles?

Answer:

Yes. Only one standing offer will be awarded, to one bidder only. This one Standing Offer will cover all service areas (Ground Handling, Hotel, vehicle rentals and the coordination of fuel delivery) Each bidder must submit one proposal only, bidding on all service areas, by completing the requested documents. These services may be subcontracted, but the Prime Contractor will be wholly responsible for the seamless delivery of all of the required services.

Clarification: Please note, for fuel coordination services, the requirement is for the coordination or for the ordering of fueling services, from a Company that already has a contract with DND. The bidder is not required to buy fuel on behalf of DND; only liaison services are required, due to possible language barrier between DND and DND's fuel provider. See SOW Para 2.3.2.
