Answer:

Pricing must be provided for the initial standing offer period as well as for the one year option period. When preparing the pricing for the option period, it is the bidder's responsibility to factor in all potential cost changes that could occur in the option period. The pricing for the initial standing offer period and the option period do not have to be the same.
