#### Answer 3:


Only end of wooden pieces facing water. Not required for floating docks

Wood supplier said that wood cannot be cut on site because CCA preservative is not available? How bracing or other wood pieces with angles cut be fitted?

## Answer 4:

Wood could be adjusted on site and fresh cut shall be protected with 3 layers of an equivalent preservative product.
