Jessie:

- Contractors responsible for approach
- No bathymetry (Re: Barge Access)
- Historic info shows landing
- Pre-mob site visit

**Q: Was it the Army Mob'ing to Island?**

- Dele noted that it was Department of Transportation site

- Sketchy info about airstrip – might be there, but far away and poor condition
- Problems with fog
- Ivujivik – 80km away (YIK) (15 min by chopper)
- Cape Dorset boat? 2 hours one way

Q: What month was site visit?

- Jessie: Both in August (1<sup>st</sup> visit: able to get to site 2 out of 8 days)

Q: Medical Emergencies? Where to?

- Jessie: nearest is Iqaluit

Q: How far?

- Nothing in Ivujivik

❖ IMPORTANT for Bidders to address this issue

- Would likely involve chopper or boat to Ivujivik and then plane to Iqaluit

- Reviewed photos
- Float planes? Won't find one.
- Bidders encouraged to look into options for transportation
- Showed barge landing area
- Be mindful of beach erosion
- We are not specifying equipment
  - Saturated conditions!!
  - All site work in small area
- Should lakes with respect to site
- Trail to lake 2
- Borrow A & B

### 01 54 00 - Scope of Work

- Wildlife protection! (Polar Bear have been seen)
- Soft-sided camps – not ruled out but will need to see safety issues addressed
- Historical significance – no concerns
- Water use / effluent
- Can't use existing structures
- Lump sum payment

### 02 41 16 – Structure Demolition

- 16 (including 2 big AST`s)
- Will be revised such that 2 AST`s will be Item 15.
- AST`s: total lead paint
- List shows hazard and non-hazardous materials.
- Will spend more time on assuming that all lead is leachable

## 02 41 23 – Debris and Miscellaneous Removals

Jessie: - info found in Appendix E (AST's will be moved to "D")

## 02 55 13 – Soil Remediation

Jessie: - 4000 m<sup>3</sup>

- PNC is Type B
- Metal is Tier II
- Co-contaminated
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Containerization:

- Type B PHC: ``Leak proof container``
- Amendment will clarify how soils will be addressed
  - 4000 will be divided: PHC (3400) / Metals & Co-Contaminated (600)
  - Still be lump sum?
  - NO..... still by m<sup>3</sup>

## 02 61 33 – Hazardous Wastes

- Not as confident as we'd like to be on quantities
- Asbestos (GORD)
  - Will provide clarifications:
    - Locations of type
    - Might eliminate "max" procedures

## 31 05 17 – AGG's / 31 22 15 – Grading

- Discussed Reshaping vs Regrading
- 600 mm is the dividing line
- Don't expect much deeper

Q: What is permafrost depth? (Jessie to look into)

## Schedule

- March 3 – Close
- End of March - Award
- Summer 2014 – pre-mob.
- Summer 2014 – mob and work
- Summer 2015 – work and demob
- March 31 2016 – contract end date

Jessie: 2 years – looking to contractors to come up with ways to achieve this.
