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PURCHASE DESCRIPTION RUBBER GRIP SLEEVES

1. SCOPE

This purchase description describes the requirements for materials, design, construction and inspection for the Canada Border Services Agency (CBSA-ASFC) rubber grip sleeve for the Beretta Px4 Storm Duty Firearm.

2. GENERAL DESIGN REQUIREMENTS

2.1 Materials: soft, durable, moulded rubber with finger grooves resistant to all oils and solvents used in maintaining firearms.

2.1.2 Colour: the rubber grip sleeve is required to be black in colour.

2.1.3 Fit: the rubber grip sleeve is required to securely fit around a small to large back strap of the Beretta Px4 Storm Duty Firearm.

The rubber grip sleeve is required to be supplied with a non-slip textured exterior for optimal hand grip.

The rubber grip sleeve must not require any lubrication for installation on the Beretta Px4 Storm Duty Firearm.

2.1.4 All articles or materials covered by this purchase description shall be free from imperfections or blemishes such as may affect its appearance or serviceability.

2.1.5 In the event of any inconsistency in the contract documents, purchase descriptions, drawings, or sealed samples, the aforementioned shall prevail in the following order:

- Contract
- Purchase Description
- Sealed Sample

3. SEALED SAMPLES

A sealed sample, identified by the purchase description number noted in the contract, will be supplied to the contractor when available. This will constitute the standard in regards to any properties not identified within. Variation from



the purchase description may appear in the sample in which case the purchase description shall govern unless otherwise identified on the sealed sample tag.

4. DETAILED DESCRIPTION

4.1 FIT:

- The rubber grip sleeve is required to securely fit around a small to large back strap of the Beretta Px4 Storm Duty Firearm.
- The rubber grip sleeve is required to be supplied with a non-slip textured exterior for optimal hand grip.
- The rubber grip sleeve must not require any lubrication for installation on the Beretta Px4 Storm Duty Firearm.

4.2 Quality:

- The rubber grip sleeve is required to have been commercially available for the past two years.
- The rubber grip sleeves are required to be free of manufactures defects upon receipt.
- Manufactures defects include rips, tears or perforations.
- All rubber grip sleeves received with manufactures defects will be replaced by the contractor at no cost to the CBSA.

5. TECHINCAL INSPECTION

The contractor shall be responsible for the inspections necessary to demonstrate that the goods being supplied conform to the requirements of this purchase description.

The CBSA Technical Authority reserves the right to perform any inspection considered necessary to ensure the goods conform to the specified requirements. For the purpose of inspection, a portion of each delivery not exceeding two percent or two out of any number delivered fewer than 100 may be inspected that could destroy the goods. If found to be inferior or not in accordance with this specification, all goods so destroyed shall be replaced by others of proper quality at the expense of the contractor. The entire delivery may also be rejected if it is found that goods previously rejected due to non-repairable defects are redelivered for inspection.

6. DELIVERY, PACKING AND MARKING OF CONTAINERS

It is the responsibility of the contractor to ensure that goods are packaged in a suitable manner to be delivered in an undamaged condition. Any goods received in a damaged container will be returned to the contractor for replacement at full cost.



Each rubber grip sleeve is required to be packaged in a plastic bag or package to preserve its shelf-life and to ensure safe arrival of goods at destination.

Packing and marking of shipping containers shall be as specified in the invitation to tender.

A packing slip shall be enclosed showing the contents of each shipment.

The contractor shall also identify clearly on the outside of each package (box) the following items:

- Material Master Number
- Quantity of each size contained in the box
- Contract Number
