Question 1

Must <u>ALL</u> Resident Site Project Administrator Liaison (RSPA) team members hold a NATO Secret clearance at the Request for Proposal stage, or we can request after the Contract award?

Answer

Please refer to the Request for Proposals, section SR2 – Mandatory Requirements.

"The Proponent and all proposed personnel <u>MUST</u> hold a valid NATO SECRET clearance <u>OR</u> a Government of Canada SECRET security clearance or above by the time of this RFP bid closing (Proposal Delivery deadline in A7). Proponents <u>MUST</u> provide the security clearance number of all proposed personnel within 48 hours of the request from DFATD. Failure to do so may render the Proposal non-compliant."

Therefore, we confirm that the Proponent and all proposed personnel must hold a SECRET NATO security clearance OR the Government of Canada SECRET security clearance by the time of RFP bid closing.

ALL OTHER TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF THE RFP REMAINS UNCHANGED.
