**QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS**

Q1: Is the area of the disposal of dredged material for the inner part the same as the outer part (the rectangle)?

A1: Disposal for Inner Area is same as Outer Area, in Rectangle CEFG, and as per Section 35 20 23 Paragraph 1.4.2, "disposal is permitted within the rectangle minimum 150m and down drift of the New Channel, and below low water".

Q2: Can the outer area be excavated by "side-casting" instead of pumping, given the results of the investigation conducted by Gemtec (TP14 and TP15)?

A2: Side casting of materials is not permitted in this Contract.

Q3: If the presence of ice extends beyond April 15 and delaying the start of work, is that the deadline of April 30 will also be pushed to completion listed in item 4.1.2 of the section 01-11-00?

A3: Should ice impede mobilization and dredging for the April 15 start date, the duration of dredging and work milestones will be extended the same amount as the delay.

Q4: Is that the new bathymetry in April in item 7.2 of section 01-11-00 is made before the commencement of work?

A4: New Hydrographic data will be made available to the Contractor before dredging commences.

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- Q5: Section 01 11 00 – 1.2 It mention “of the material to be excavated”. Can a method of suction dredging can be use or it can only be excavated?
- A5: Dredging with cutter suction dredge and disposal via a pipeline is an acceptable dredging method.
- Q6: Section 35 20 23 item 1.13 Floating Plant. Does Certification mean Certificate of Registry from Transport Canada?
- A6: Floating Plant is to conform to General Instructions GI 06. Certificate of Registry from Transport Canada will provide information of compliance, ie. Proof of registry.
