Question and Answer #1

- Q1. M7 indicates a letter of good standing with the Pharmacists's Association of Saskatchewan is required. Since service is being provided in Manitoba would a letter from the Manitoba College of Pharmacists suffice?
- A1. Yes, a letter from the Manitoba College will suffice
- Q2. The document requires delivery to Dauphin, Manitoba. Would you be able to provide a detailed address?
- A2. Delivery is not required. Offenders are escorted to the doctor and subsequently to the pharmacy to pick up their medications.
- Q3. Is the Healing Lodge set up in a way that a stat box could be provided for urgent medications?
- A3. No, there is no stat box on site but a locked filing cabinet on site to hold the medications until the offenders require them (staff have 24 hour access)
- Q4. Are there any restrictions on the types of medications allowed at the healing lodge? For example methadone, narcotics, sleeping pills or other psychotropic medications.
- A4. Yes, according to the Lodge methadone and narcotics are not kept on site and other alternatives are requested should a medication not be kept at the Lodge.
- Q5. What is the general length of stay at the Healing Lodge?
- A5. 6 months minimum with some staying for up to two years.
- Q6. Are you requiring daily delivery?
- A6. No, as noted in #1, delivery is not required. If this is in the RFP, I am suggesting that it be removed from the RFP.
