Amendment 1 is raised to do the following:

- Make changes to the requirements of the solicitation; and
- Answer questions from bidders (Q&A).

**1. At the Invitation to Tender, Part 2 “Information and Instructions to Bidders”, Article 9
“Evaluation Procedures”:**

Delete: b) Clearly demonstrate that the bidder is part of the Canine Good Neighbour Program from the Canadian Kennel Club by providing valid copies of certificates.

Replace with: b) Clearly demonstrate that the bidder is part of the Canine Good Neighbour Program from the Canadian Kennel Club or a certified Goose Management Professional from the (NWCOA) National Wildlife Control Operators Association by providing valid copies of certificates to demonstrate.

**2. At the Invitation to Tender, Part 2 “Information and Instructions to Bidders”, Article 9
“Evaluation Procedures”:**

Delete: c) Include two (2) references of recent clients to verify this experience. These 2 references must include contact names and phone numbers.

Replace with: c) Include two (2) references of recent clients (within the last 3 years) for whom such services were performed on a 50 hectares (123.6 acres) area or more. Those two (2) references must include contact names and phone numbers.

Q&A

Q1. Is this requirement restricted to the use of dogs as a scaring technique?

A1. Yes this requirement is limited to the use of dogs as a scaring technique.

Q2. Can the requirement about providing a valid certificate as part of the Canine Good Neighbour Program from the Canadian Kennel Club be modified or removed?

A2. No, but AAFC is including one more certification that will be considered. See the included above changes to the solicitation.
