- 2. At the Invitation to Tender, Part 2 "Information and Instructions to Bidders", Article 9 "Evaluation Procedures":
- **Delete:** c) Include two (2) references of recent clients to verify this experience. These 2 references must include contact names and phone numbers.
- **Replace with:** c) Include two (2) references of recent clients (within the last 3 years) for whom such services were performed on a 50 hectares (123.6 acres) area or more. Those two (2) references must include contact names and phone numbers.

- Q1. Is this requirement restricted to the use of dogs as a scaring technique?
- A1. Yes this requirement is limited to the use of dogs as a scaring technique.
- Q2. Can the requirement about providing a valid certificate as part of the Canine Good Neighbour Program from the Canadian Kennel Club be modified or removed?
