THIS ADDENDUM HAS BEEN RAISED TO EFFECT THE FOLLOWING CHANGES:

1. at section 3.4.4 (g) in Response Preparation Instructions and General information:

Delete :

In addition to the pages described at 3.4.4 a. and c., the Respondent may include a maximum of two 11 x 17 inch (279 mm x 432 mm) sheets in the Response, printed on both sides, with text no smaller than Arial font size 8, in order to provide their organisational chart in response to rated criteria in Package 2: –Team Partnering (Appendix C – Rated Evaluation Criteria).

Replace with:

In addition to the pages described at 3.4.4 a. and c., the Respondent may include a maximum of four (4) 11 x 17 inch (279 mm x 432 mm) pages in the Response, with text no smaller than Arial font size 8, in order to provide their organizational chart in response to rated criteria in Package 2 –Team Partnering (Appendix C – Rated Evaluation Criteria).

2. at Appendix C – Rated Evaluation Criteria, Package 2 – Team Partnering, Criterion 2-1 page limits:

Delete:

5 pages including two (2) 11x17 pages

Replace with:

Seven (7) pages including four (4) 11x17 pages, not including bidding agreements or teaming agreements.

3. At Section 3.4.4 (c) in Response Preparation Instructions and General information:

Delete :

The text should not be smaller than Arial font size 10. Page count limitations do not apply for Package 1 (Appendix B – Mandatory Forms and Certifications). Page limitations are identified per criterion within Appendix C – Rated Evaluation Criteria. Any additional pages will not be considered for evaluation;

Replace with:

The text should not be smaller than Arial font size 10. Page count limitations do not apply to 3.4.4 (e), 3.4.4. (f) and for Package 1 (Appendix B – Mandatory Forms and Certifications).

Page limitations are identified per criterion within Appendix C – Rated Evaluation Criteria. Any additional pages will not be considered for evaluation;

Delete :

- a) The audited annual financial statements for the last three available fiscal years and, if available, quarterly financial statements for each quarter since the last annual financial statement produced; when audited annual financial statements are not available, unaudited annual financial statements should be provided; Acceptable audit standards for Financial Statements are Generally Accepted Accounting Principles (GAAP) and International Financial Reporting Standards (IFRS).

5. at Package 3, Criterion 3-8, Response Submission Requirements

Delete :

The Equity Members and Prime Members should provide a letter of intent as evidence of their ability to obtain:

- A letter of credit for the Project totalling at least \$300 million; or
- A performance bond totaling at least \$1.0 billion; and,

- A labour and material bond totaling at least \$750 million.

Equity Members and Prime Members should provide the required letter of intent from either a Financial Institution or an acceptable Bonding Company*.
