- Q1 As per list of proposed work, are we to include 8"depth of excavation and the supply and placement of 6" depth gravel A base, or will this work be done by another contract prior to paving contractor arrival.
- A1 This contract is for the excavation and filling of A base gravel and asphalt.
- **Q2** Then insurance section that is referred to in the insurance terms documents is R2910D. I have found these documents but they are in the archived files, so I am wondering if they are still the valid insurance requirements for this project?
- **A2** The Invitation to Tender document (ITT) now contains a link to Certificate of Insurance (form PWGSC-TPSGC 357); R2910D has been removed from SACC as this is provided for in the ITT. The insurance requirement remains the same.
- Q3 I cannot find any penalties or liquidated damages referred to in these documents, are there any?
- **A3** There are no performance incentives or penalties associated with this requirement.
- Q4 What is the warranty period for this project?
- **A4** There is a 1 year warranty period for this requirement.
- Q5 There are 2 areas where the completion date is conflicting BA06 states September 30, 2014 1.10 states October 31, 2014, which one would it be?
- A5 October 31, 2014 is the correct completion date
- **Q6** Bid validity is specified in various places and for different lengths of time...will it be the **30** day as specified in **BA04**?
- A6 The Validity period is as defined in the Solicitation document 30 days
